Watching her navigate it all has bene awesome to witness, both in her success and her challenges.

# And she has handled those challenges with such poise and grace, working hard and loving well.

There is something profoundly human about showing up when the conditions are less than perfect. It is in those moments

that we can see the full extent of our resilience, and it is in those moments that love shows itself.

In Jacob's case, his labor wasn't just for the sake of the game—it was for his teammates and for the love he had for the sport itself. The work he put into each practice, each rainy day, will one day help him achieve something greater. For Ryleigh, her labor was every direction read and tutorial watched. Each redone stitch so it was just right. And for Ellie, it has been all the hours learning what it means to really study, each road bump talked through, every honest conversation had.
